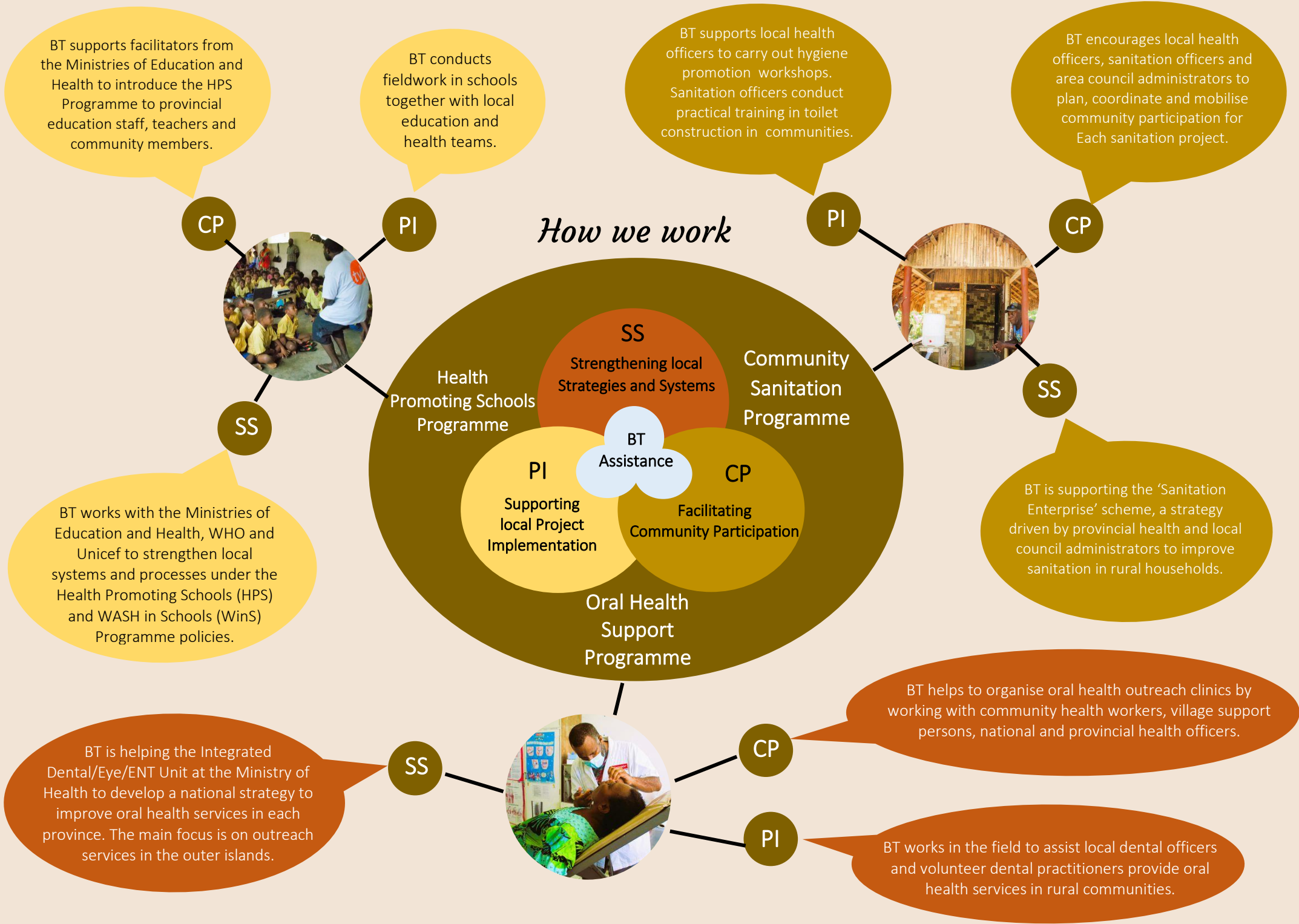


How we work



BT supports facilitators from the Ministries of Education and Health to introduce the HPS Programme to provincial education staff, teachers and community members.

CP



BT conducts fieldwork in schools together with local education and health teams.

PI

BT supports local health officers to carry out hygiene promotion workshops. Sanitation officers conduct practical training in toilet construction in communities.

PI



BT encourages local health officers, sanitation officers and area council administrators to plan, coordinate and mobilise community participation for Each sanitation project.

CP

BT works with the Ministries of Education and Health, WHO and Unicef to strengthen local systems and processes under the Health Promoting Schools (HPS) and WASH in Schools (WinS) Programme policies.

SS

BT is supporting the 'Sanitation Enterprise' scheme, a strategy driven by provincial health and local council administrators to improve sanitation in rural households.

SS

BT is helping the Integrated Dental/Eye/ENT Unit at the Ministry of Health to develop a national strategy to improve oral health services in each province. The main focus is on outreach services in the outer islands.

SS



BT helps to organise oral health outreach clinics by working with community health workers, village support persons, national and provincial health officers.

CP

BT works in the field to assist local dental officers and volunteer dental practitioners provide oral health services in rural communities.
